Does the organisation have systems and procedures in place to ensure that it complies with its obligations in respect of the release of odours?

Water Management

Waste Management

Does the organisation have policies and procedures in place to ensure that waste is stored where it will not enter the environment, that waste is transported and disposed of by licensed companies, and that controlled waste is monitored and reported on to the appropriate regulator?			

Does the organisation develop, implement and apply waste storage procedures that prevent the release of waste into the environment?

Does the organisation have systems and procedures in place to ensure that waste it generates is only disposed of at licensed facilities? Does the organisation ensure that the transporter has the appropriate environmental approval?

If the organisation plans to transport controlled waste, does it monitor the waste and report this activity to the state/territory regulator of every state/territory through which the waste will be transported?

Does the operator of a waste facility or disposal premises in New South Wales, Queensland and Victoria ensure that the correct levy amount is paid within the required time period and all surveys, measurements, reports and returns have been completed and appropriate records retained?

Does the operator of a waste facility or disposal premises in South Australia, Western Australia and Tasmania ensure that the correct levy amount is paid within the required time period and all surveys, measurements, reports and returns have been completed and appropriate records retained?
